Formerly published by the now dissolved Association for Volunteer Administration (AVA) and known as *The Journal of Volunteer Administration*, two on-line issues of Volume XXIV of *The IJOVA* have been published to date, including:

Thanks to the generosity of IMPACT: A Fund for Change Through Volunteerism (i.e., The Volunteer IMPACT Fund, to which The UPS Foundation is a lead contributor), the four issues of Volume XXIV are provided as public domain, available free of charge to anyone with access to the Web. *The IJOVA* will move to a subscription only Web-based publication as of 1 July 2007. Subscription rates will include an individual subscription rate of \$40; and prorated organizational subscription rates will be based upon numbers of organizational members: \$30 per member for 01-200 members, \$20 per member for 201-500 members, \$10 per member for 501-1500 members, and \$5 per member for more than 1500 members.
